- 1. Pool parties are permitted at the Crabapple Lake Parc Pool (5015 Baywood Drive) with board approval submitted a minimum of 14 days prior to party date.
- 2. A planned gathering in excess of the applicable guest policy, four accompanied guests per household, will be required to submit a Pool Party Request.
- 3. Advanced booking must be made with the Community Association Manager (770)-575-0943 or info@sixesmanagement.com
- 4. There is a two hour maximum for all parties
- 5. One adult must be present for every three children under the age of 12
- 6. No more than two parties will be permitted on the same day, and will not be permitted at the same time
- 7. The lifeguard on duty must sign off on this form confirming your area was properly cleaned up and no damage was done. All damages will be billed to the homeowner and deposit will be forfeited.
- 8. This form must be returned to the Community Association Manager
- 9. The homeowner must be in "good standing" with the community in regards to annual association fees and maintenance agreements.
- 10. Parties of 10 or more will be required to hire an additional lifeguard at the current rate. Guards will be booked by the association and must be requested at time of submission of this form.
- 11. Deposit of \$250 (not including lifeguard cost) must be paid in full 7 days prior to party. Deposit will be returned upon lifeguard sign off as noted below, and homeowner returning this form to Sixes Management.
- 12. The requesting homeowner is responsible for all attendees and will be subject to forfeiture of deposit if behavior or actions become unruly at lifeguard's discretion.
- 13. Pool parties are requested to be during non-peak hours. Peak hours on weekends are typically 2-5 pm.
- 14. Lifeguards have absolute authority and will be obeyed at all times.
